RIGHT-OF-WAY DEDICATION INSTRUMENT

COUNTY OF KERR §

For and in consideration of the sum of ten dollars (\$10.00), and other good and valuable consideration, in hand paid by the City of Ingram, Texas ("GRANTEE"), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Evelyn Vela ("GRANTOR"), of Kerr County, Texas, as the owner of that certain 19.49 acre tract of land in Kerr County, Texas more particularly described in Instrument No. 14-04876 of the Real Property Records of Kerr County, Texas upon which tract a portion of Main Street sits as shown on the plat attached to Instrument No. 14-04876, does hereby dedicate a forty foot (40') right-of-way easement to the City of Ingram, Kerr County, Texas for the use and benefit of the public as a perpetual right-of-way and easement for the passage and accommodation of vehicular and pedestrian traffic, and the construction, operation, use, maintenance, inspection, repair, alteration, enlargement, improvement, and replacement of a paved public street and rightof-way within the boundaries of the right-of-way and easement area, and for all other purposes for which a public street and right-of-way is commonly used, including installing, repairing, maintaining, altering, replacing, relocating and operating utilities in, into, upon, over, across, and under said right-of-way, and including but not limited to all such uses permitted by the Laws of the State of Texas and the Ordinances of the City of Ingram, Texas. Said easement shall be twenty feet (20') to both sides of the center line of Main Street as shown on the plat attached to Instrument No. 14-04876.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said right-of-way and easement unto the City of Ingram, its successors and assigns, and GRANTOR hereby binds itself, its successors and assigns to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, said premises unto the City of Ingram, its successors and assigns, against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. GRANTOR covenants and agrees that GRANTOR and GRANTOR'S representatives, successors and assigns shall at no time erect, place or construct, or cause to be erected, placed or constructed in, into, upon, over, across or under any easements granted herein any temporary or permanent structures, and it is further agreed that the City of Ingram shall have the right to

excavate, remove and fill upon said permanent easement, any fences, buildings or other obstructions as may now be found upon said permanent easement. It is further intended that the permanent right of way and easement herein granted to the City of Ingram shall run with the land and forever be a right in and to the land belonging to GRANTOR, and GRANTOR'S successors and assigns, and said grant is expressly excepted from any right of reversion of said premises under any prior deeds in GRANTOR'S chain of title. The permanent right—of-way and easement rights and privileges granted herein are exclusive, and GRANTOR covenants that it will not convey any other easement or conflicting rights within the area covered by the grant to any other person or entity.


