

## 2025 General Election

The next General Election for the City of Ingram will be Saturday, May 3, 2025. Filing for place on the ballot is set by <u>state statute</u> and will run from January 15, 2025 to February 14, 2025.

## Filing Method of Candidate Application

A candidate application may be filled in person, by mail, by fax, or by email. The candidate application (English and Spanish) can be downloaded and printed via the Texas Secretary of State's website: Application For A Place on the Ballot For a General Election

- Filing in Person: City Secretary's Office, City Hall, 230 Hwy 39, Ingram, TX 78025
- <u>Filling by Mail</u>: An application submitted by mail is considered to be filed at the time of its receipt by the appropriate filing authority. (Sections 143.007(b); 144.005(b)) Please be advised that an application must be notarized prior to filing via mail. The mailing address is City Hall, Attn: City Secretary, 230 Hwy 39, Ingram, TX 78025
- <u>Filing by Fax or Email</u>: A signed, sworn, scanned candidate application (and petition, if applicable) may be submitted by fax or email. Please be advised that an application must be notarized prior to filing via fax or email.

If submitting an Application for Place on the Ballot on January 15, doors to the City Hall Council Chambers will open at 8:00 am. Applicants are welcome to enter when doors open and take a seat in order of arrival. Applications will not be accepted until 8:30 am.

The first day to apply for a ballot by mail using Application for a Ballot by Mail (ABBM) or Federal Post Card Application (FPCA) is January 1, 2025. The last day to apply for ABBM (received, not postmarked) is April 22, 2025. For more information, please visit the <u>Texas</u> Secretary of State's website.

These positions will serve a two-year term.

Elections in the City of Ingram are conducted in accordance with the <u>Texas Election Code</u> and the <u>City Charter</u>. Formore information, contact the <u>City Charter</u>.

Voter registration is handled by <u>Kerr County Elections Administrator</u> and the <u>Texas Secretary</u> of State.
